
REMOTE CONTROL

● TWS (True Wireless Stereo) MODE

Place two Mifa MT800 units next to one another.

- Press MODE on both units until Bluetooth mode is selected.
- On one of the units, press and hold TWS button until the display shows "TWS" to connect units.
- On a smart device, search for Mifa MT800 within the Bluetooth menu and connect to it.
- The audio file will now be able to play from your smart device to both music players.

TOP CONTROL PANEL OVERVIEW



- 1. Light Switch: On/Off light
- 2. Wired Microphone Input: Plug the microphone wire into either of these jacks
- 3. AUX In: Play the file on the device connected to the AUX input
- 4. USB Input: Insert USB to play
- 5. TF Card Input: Insert TF Card to play
- 6. Power: On/Off power
- 7. Mic. Pri: Microphone priority
- 8. Repeat Function: Press to repeat one & repeat all
- 9. TWS: True Wireless Stereo function
- 10. Record Function: Short press will record in the USB/TF Card's "RECORD" file. Long press will play recorded file.
- 11. Light Switch: Press to change light color and light style.
- 12. EQ: Press to change Equalizer type (6 Equalizer types).
- 13. Main Volume: Turn the knob to adjust master volume level and Mic volume.


- 14. Mode: Short press to select LINE (Aux-in)/USB /FM /Wireless BT mode; long press to on/off voice prompt.
- 15. Next Song: Short press to get next sound/channel; long press to fast forward.

Previous Song: Short press to get previous sound/channel; long press to fast backward.

Pause & Play: Short press to pause and play music; long press to switch folder in USB/TF memory card.

- 16. MENU: Short press to toggle Bass/Treble/Mic Volume/Mic Echo; long press to turn the volume to 5.
- 17. MEGA BASS: Gives the sound a stronger bass effect (press to on/off).

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

WIRELESS BT MODE:

- Press MODE and select Bluetooth (Blue) mode for Bluetooth paring.
- Once Bluetooth mode is selected, your music player will automatically enter pairing mode if not already paired to another device.
- Search for the model number Mifa MT800 on your Bluetooth menu on the smart device and select it.
- Once selected, the smart device and music player will connect. When connected you can control your music player through the top panel controls or the smart device.

LINE IN MODE:

- Press MODE until AUX is selected.
- Make sure a 3.5mm AUX cable is plugged into your audio device from the AUX port on the top of music player.
- In AUX mode, you can only control the functions through the audio device; although, you can adjust the volume on either device.

FM RADIO MODE

Press MODE until FM Radio is selected.

- Press the P/P (Play/Pause) button to auto scan FM Radio stations. All available stations will be stored Automatically.
- Press the NEXT or PREVIOUS button to navigate through the saved radio stations.

USB AND TE CARD MODE

NOTE: Please make sure a USB Drive or TF Card is inserted in the USB/TF Card port located on the top of the music player.

- Press MODE until USB/TF Card is selected.
- You can use the control on the top of your music player to navigate through songs (tracks), play/pause, volume.
