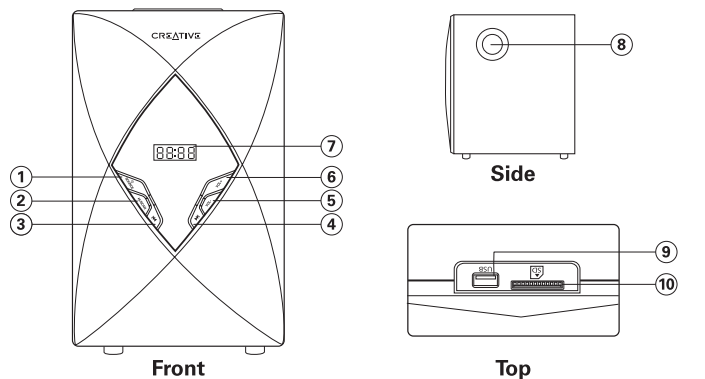

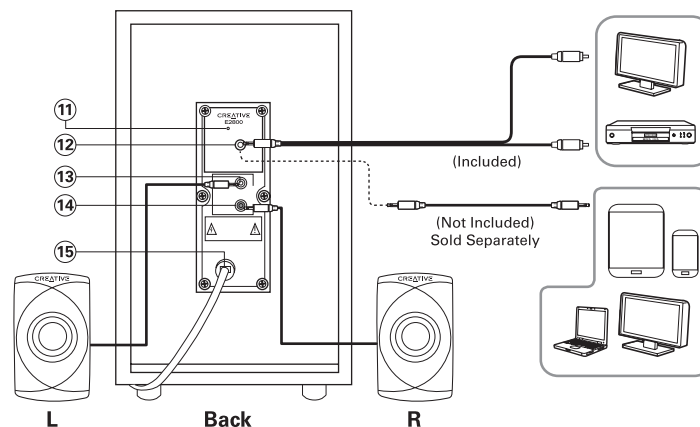
To Power ON/OFF Speaker

- Speaker is at "Standby" mode when power supply is switched on, with LED display showing "----". Press / Source" button to switch the speaker on. Press and hold / Source" button to let the speaker enter into "Standby" mode again.

To Switch between Sources

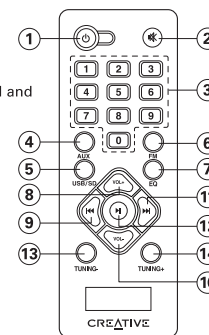
- Press / Source" on the subwoofer panel to switch source. You can choose "Aux / USB / SD / FM" input mode consecutively. ("Au" means "AUX" input mode; "Ud or Sd" means "USB or SD" input mode; "87.5" means "FM" mode.)

Infra Remote Control

- Power On or standby**
- Mute:** Turns volume off. Press again to unmute.
- 0 - 9:** Press your desired track or stored FM station preset channel and press to jump to respective track / FM station
- Aux:** AUX input mode selection
- USB / SD:** USB / SD reader mode selection
- FM:** FM tuner mode selection
- EQ:** Normal, Classic, Pop, Jazz, Rock, Country (USB/SD mode)
- Volume +:** Volume level 00 - 30 (max)
- Previous Track**
- Volume -:** Volume level 00 - 30 (max)
- Next Track**
- Play / Pause**
- TUNING-**
- TUNING+**



- When you enter FM mode, press and hold to automatic search FM radio stations. Press "Next" or "Previous" to change stored FM memory stations.
- Press "TUNING+/-" each time to search channel step by step (each step 0.1MHz). Press and hold "TUNING+/-" to search for next available channel. Once found, it will play the channel automatically.
